The official publication of the East Zone Indian Psychiatric Society was relaunched during the Mid-Year Conference 2024 in Guwahati, Assam.

Creative Commons (CC) is a nonprofit organization that provides free, legally sound tools to enable the sharing and use of creativity and knowledge through free legal licenses. These licenses allow creators to grant permission for others to use their work under certain conditions, making it easier to share, remix, and reuse content. With the strategy of "Creating a brighter future through better, more ethical sharing," CC aims to address global challenges and create a brighter future for all through open access and the responsible sharing of resources.

Why Creative Commons?
 CC licenses, gives you the freedom to take control of the visibility and accessibility of your work, leading to greater impact and recognition. These licenses offer clear legal frameworks, making it easier to share your work while retaining control over its use.

- Benefits for Creators:**
- Flexibility:** CC licenses offer a range of options, from the most permissive (CC BY) to more restrictive (CC BY-NC-ND), allowing authors to retain control over how their work is used while promoting openness and dissemination.
 - Global Standards:** Recognized and respected worldwide, CC licenses provide a universal framework that surpasses geographical and legal boundaries, making research universally accessible.
 - Promoting Collaboration:** One of the key benefits of using CC licenses is that they encourage the reuse and adaptation of works. This grows collaboration and innovation within the academic community, leading to a richer and more diverse knowledge landscape.

Understanding Creative Commons Licenses: Types and Uses in Journal Publishing and Beyond

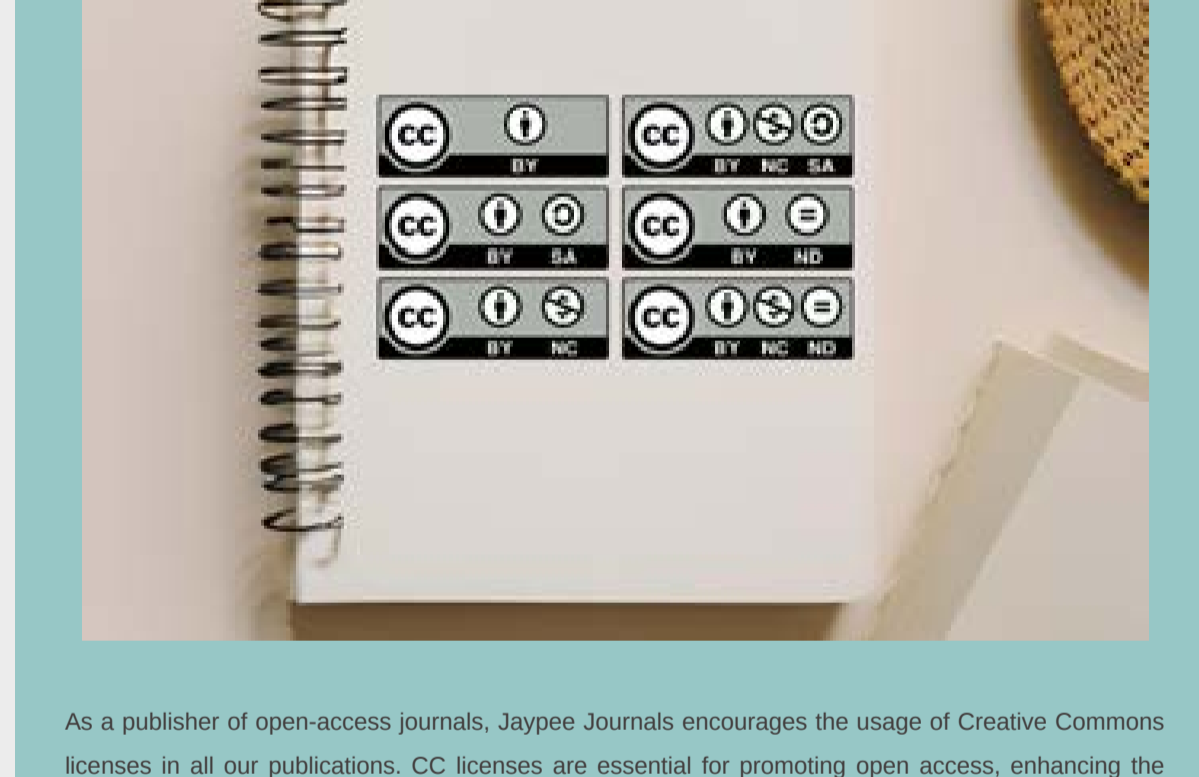


Creative Commons (CC) licenses provide a flexible range of protections and freedoms for authors in academic publishing. By applying for a CC license, you can customize how others may use your work, ensuring it remains accessible while protecting your rights. Here are the different types of CC licenses and their uses, with examples related to journal publishing and other creative works:

- 1. CC BY (Attribution)**
Usage: This license allows others to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon your work, even commercially, as long as they credit you for the original creation.
Example:
 - Journal Publishing:** A researcher publishes an article in a journal under a CC BY license. Other researchers can freely use, adapt, and build upon this article in their research papers, provided they acknowledge the original author.
 - Open-Source Codes:** A developer releases software code under a CC BY license. Other developers can use, modify, and distribute the code, including in commercial projects, as long as they credit the original developer.
- 2. CC BY-SA (Attribution-Share Alike)**
Usage: This license lets others remix, adapt, and build upon your work, even for commercial purposes, as long as they credit you and license their new creations under identical terms.
Example:
 - Journal Publishing:** An author publishes a review article under a CC BY-SA license. Other authors can modify and use this review in their publications, but any derivative work must also be shared under a CC BY-SA license.
 - Open Educational Resources:** A tutor shares a textbook under a CC BY-SA license. Other tutors can adapt and redistribute the textbook, but any new version must be shared under the same license.
- 3. CC BY-ND (Attribution-No Derivatives)**
Usage: This license allows for redistribution, commercial and non-commercial, as long as it is passed unchanged and in whole, with credit to you.
Example:
 - Journal Publishing:** A researcher publishes a study under a CC BY-ND license. Colleagues can share the study in its original form, but they cannot modify or adapt the study. Credit must be given to the original researcher.
 - Multimedia:** A photographer releases images under a CC BY-ND license. Others can use the images in their original form for presentations, but they cannot alter them.
- 4. CC BY-NC (Attribution-Non-Commercial)**
Usage: This license lets others remix, adapt, and build upon your work for non-commercial purposes. Their new works must also acknowledge you and be non-commercial, but they don't have to license their derivative works on the same terms.
Example:
 - Journal Publishing:** An author publishes an open-access article under a CC BY-NC license. Others can use, adapt, and distribute the article for classroom teaching, in an article or any educational purpose, but they cannot sell it or use it for commercial purposes.
 - Open Data:** A research team releases a dataset under a CC BY-NC license. Other researchers can use and adapt the data for their studies, but cannot sell the derived datasets.
- 5. CC BY-NC-SA (Attribution-Non-Commercial-Share Alike)**
Usage: This license allows others to remix, adapt, and build upon your work non-commercially, as long as they credit you and license their new creations under the identical terms.
Example:
 - Journal Publishing:** A researcher shares supplementary data from a published article under a CC BY-NC-SA license. Other researchers can use and modify this data for their non-commercial research, but any new data must be shared under the same license.
 - Creative Works:** A writer releases a novel under a CC BY-NC-SA license. Fans can create non-commercial adaptations, like fan fiction, as long as they share their work under the same license.
- 6. CC BY-NC-ND (Attribution-Non-Commercial-No Derivatives)**
Usage: This is the most restrictive license, allowing others to download your work and share them with others as long as they credit you, but they can't change them in any way or use them commercially.
Example:
 - Journal Publishing:** A scholar publishes a commentary in a journal under a CC BY-NC-ND license. Colleagues can share the commentary but cannot modify it or use it for commercial purposes, ensuring the work remains unchanged and properly credited.
 - Open Data:** A nonprofit organization releases a research report under a CC BY-NC-ND license. Other nonprofits can share the report with their stakeholders but cannot alter its content or use it for commercial activities.
- 7. CC0 (Public Domain Dedication)**
Usage: This license liberates creators from copyright restrictions, allowing them to waive all their rights in their works and dedicate them to the public domain, making them freely available for any use without restrictions.
Example:
 - Journal Publishing:** A research team publishes raw experimental data under CC0. Other researchers can use, adapt, and share this data without any restrictions, facilitating wide-ranging collaboration and advancement in the field.
 - Open-Source Codes:** A developer releases a piece of software under CC0. Other developers can freely use, modify, and integrate the software into their projects without any need for attribution. Similarly, a photographer could release a collection of high-quality images under CC0, allowing anyone to use them for any purpose without restrictions.

By understanding and utilizing these licenses, authors and creators can effectively manage how their work is shared and used, promoting an environment of openness and collaboration across various fields.
